

Thank you for choosing Pottery-To-Go from us! For successful pottery painting:

Clean Hands	Dirty Hands
Washable marker or ballpoint pen to plan images/lettering	Sharpie, crayons
Our paints/glazes	Any other paint
Painters tape	Any other adhesive

- Wipe off dust with clean, damp sponge
- Start with lighter colors first. Whatever you don't paint will be shiny white.
- Glaze goes on in thin coats, letting paint dry between coats. 3 coats is a good solid coverage.
- Dark is better over light. Light colors don't show up as well over dark
- ▶ Try Q-tips or end of paintbrush for dots
- Try a toothpick to etch
- Fill out Kiln Ticket and return with pottery. Keep pink copy for yourself. (Disregard note that pottery will be done in 7 days.)

When you're finished, bring your pottery back. We'll call you when your pottery is done.
